Program Status



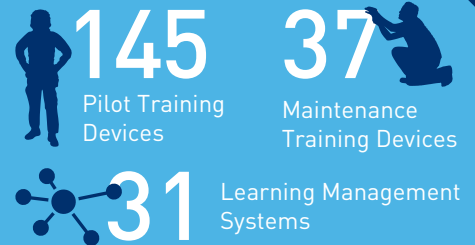
Cost Reduction

Lockheed Martin reduced the cost of an F-35 Mission Simulator by \$3 million per copy since program inception, reflected in Low Rate Initial Production (LRIP) lot 11. This generated \$45 million in savings under the LRIP 11 contract comprised of 15 simulators.

Economic Impact

- 290 top-tier F-35 training suppliers around the globe
- Suppliers located in 31 U.S. states and 6 international locations
- \$251 Million spent with suppliers in 2024
